Maha Weeks has been working in enamels and metalsmithing since 2017 when her parents left her their jewelry studio with all their tools. As an artist, enamels and metalsmithing have completely enchanted her, and she has had the privilege of studying with some wonderful master enamelists such as Ricky Frank, Merry-Lee Rae, and Darci Shea

With a strong interest in mythology and natural motifs, Maha explores figurative work through cloisonne, transparent enamels, mason stains, and painting enamels. She has been teaching metalsmithing and enameling first in Hawaii and later in Idaho, and is very proud of introducing a metalworking program at Leilehua High School on Oahu. It is without a doubt, one of her greatest joys to see the passion for creating ignited in her students. Currently, she teaches enameling out of her home and at Fire Fusion Gallery in Boise.

In this class you will create your own enamel earrings and pendants, with the option to try P3 underglaze to emphasize texture, and explore simple fold forming for your metal base. We will use copper sheet, opaque and transparent enamels, lead free, and our various enameling tools to wet-pack and fuse our enamels to the metal bases.
